
The survey analysis revealed the following points:


























## 17. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities.


# 18. Efforts are made by the institute/teachers to inculcate soft skills, and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.


# 19. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia etc. while teaching?
